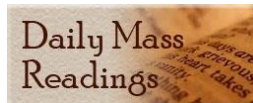

FFF (Family of Faith Formation) Topics for January: Who Is Jesus? What does Jesus reveal to us through His life? Why is Baptism a "big deal" for Catholics?

➤ **January's Family Faith Formation Overview.** Lesson 6: Through His life Jesus reveals the truth of who He is, the life He's planned for us, and the way to live in order to spend eternity with Him in Heaven. Lesson 7: Upon receiving a Christian baptism (In the Name of the Father, Son, Holy Spirit) all our sins are forgiven, including Original Sin, and God restores our inheritance which includes partaking in God's Divine Life as His adopted children.
